There are several ways to raise much-needed funds to support homeless people this Summer – can you help?

The year so far

2024 has continued to see heavy demand for our services. Reflecting rising homelessness across London, the Drop-in has regularly welcomed around 50 homeless and vulnerably housed people every session. Meanwhile, demand for our Winter Night Shelter beds remained high throughout the winter months to mid-March. And thanks to additional funding from the Mayor of London, our night shelter guests were offered further respite from the cold and wet in hotel accommodation for several further weeks into April.



But these unprecedented levels of demand continue to place pressures on our finances. Consequently, we need to increase our income to ensure we can continue to fund the level of professional services we now offer, further impacted by the increased cost of our accommodation, energy, food, and other ancillary costs. This year we have been successful in bidding for grants from the National Lottery and the London Borough of Merton. However, these alone will not bridge the financial gap, so we need to increase our income from both regular giving and one-off sponsored events.
